Included in the program:

Group airport transfers as per the itinerary.

Israeli Tour Educator: From the start of the program as per the Itinerary until the end of the program

Counselors/Chaperons: Two counselors/chaperons for every group of 40 participants

Transportation: By licensed air-conditioned vehicle, to fit group size, as per the itinerary

Accommodations: In good 3-4 star hotels and Kibbutz Guest Houses, based on 2-4 persons sharing a room (participants will always share a room), with en-suite facilities and air conditioning. Each participant will sleep in a separate bed.

Meals: Include full Israeli Breakfast (buffet), lunch and dinner daily (all kosher meals) [meals are handled in a variety of ways: breakfast usually buffet at the hotel, lunch meals are in restaurants, "Pizur" (sum of money given to each participant to buy their own food – normally we provide three participants with sum of money so they learn to share as well), pizza parties and bagged lunch (rarely), dinner meals are either at hotel or restaurants on rare occasions also "Pizur"]

Educational programming and special events – As set forth in the itinerary

Educational materials – Will be provided by Oranim, based on materials available

Dedicated website, pictures and e-mail delivery service

Taxes and service charges are included (as per current Israel's tax laws in Israel)

24-hour emergency contact service

Laundry: 2-3 laundry stops throughout the trip (4 kg maximum each participant)

Security: The group will be escorted from its arrival in Israel until its departure from Israel by an armed medic. The medic will provide basic emergency medical assistance only, as well as safety. Oranim receives real-time updates from the Society for the Protection of Nature in Israel (SPNI). The SPNI runs the Situation Room and coordinates all tours for the Ministry of Education and other official bodies in Israel, with the Army, Police and other security services. The Tour Educator will be in touch with the Oranim Educational Initiatives Office where he will receive updates. The itinerary is subject to change without prior notice in the case of a security reason decided upon by Oranim Educational Initiatives

Baggage allowance: For safety and convenience we ask that each participant limit themselves to only 1 piece of luggage (up to 50 lbs) and one carry on piece of luggage (up to 10 lbs) in accordance with airline regulations. No responsibility is accepted for loss or damage to baggage or any of the passengers' belongings.

Insurance: Oranim Educational Initiatives is proud to carry no-fault insurance and professional liability insurance, above the industry standard up to the sum of \$10,000,000 (US). General liability insurance covers bodily injury and property damage or loss due to any activity of the organizer everywhere in Israel with liability limits of \$20,000,000 (US dollars) for any one occurrence and in the aggregate and \$10,000,000 to cover worldwide jurisdiction. A copy of the policy can be provided upon request.

Health Insurance: Health insurance is provided throughout the stay in Israel, from time of arrival until time of departure (also during the stay with families). The policy covers transportation to hospital. The policy does not cover pre-existing conditions with the exception of Diabetes, Asthma and allergies (provided the participant was treated and was under stable conditions during six months prior to the trip, doctors proof will be required). Emergency medical air evacuation is included as well as limited assistance of relatives' flights and stay in Israel during required hospitalization in Israel. Not included:

- Transfers from the passengers’ residence to the departure gateway and back.
- Domestic (US) flights to the departure gateway
- Tips and gratuities for guide, driver and armed escort (Suggested: per Guide: \$60, per Driver: \$30 and per Armed escort \$10) – **will be collected separately**
- Items of personal nature: room charges, telephones, minibar etc.
- Snacks
- Drinks at meals, other than those provided by the restaurant.
- Porterage
- Passport and Visa Fees (It is the responsibility of each traveler to have the necessary documents prior to departure)

Travel Insurance: We highly recommend taking out comprehensive travel insurance, which should cover emergency evacuation, cancellation, delay, illness, loss or damage to personal belongings and luggage, etc. Contact our office for more details (you can purchase Travel Guard directly online on your dedicated website).

Cancellations:

If for any reason you cancel participation, we will charge cancellation fees based on how far in advance of the trip you notify us. Cancellation fees are not imposed to punish, we try hard to keep them as low as possible. They represent a very real combination of administrative expenses, forgone economic opportunities and non-recoverable deposits.

* A portion of your payments are used for deposits for services which may be non refundable. This is specifically due to airline charges to hold seats. If the deposit for seats on the group flight is non-refundable, we will not be able to return that portion of your deposit.

In case of cancellation during the trip, no refund will be given for unused services and all expenses and all costs relating to returning the participant to his or her home will be the sole responsibility of the participant's family.
